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## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Dates: Encampments must first check-in with Bobby before set up; the dates runs from January 28<sup>th</sup>, 29<sup>th</sup>, February 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017, from 10am - 4pm. The Encampment agrees to render said services at the Festival on the following dates and at the following times: February 11-March 26, 2017, including Monday, President's Day for regular hours and one (1) School Day on Monday, February 13, 2017 from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Encampment agrees that a Manager shall be designated as the person in charge, and shall be present on the premises and exercising supervision of the operation at all times in which the premises are open to the public.

Participants: All participants volunteering in the Encampment at the Festival must be listed on the Festival I.D. Pass Registration Form, which includes their full legal name and date of birth. Each individual will be required to present a valid State I.D. prior to being issued a Festival I.D. Each individual participating at the Festival will be checked against State and Federal Sexual Predator Databases; in no event will a Registered Sex Offender be admitted as a participant. Additionally, each participant must fully read and execute an Agreement for Participation in Florida Renaissance Festival prior to being issued an I.D. Pass.

Events on Festival Premises: Encampments are strictly prohibited from holding after-hours events, parties, or get-togethers on Festival Premises. Encampments may be permitted to hold an after-hours event on Festival Premises in their Encampment space, if the Festival Producer is notified in advance and gives approval for such event; approval will given on a case-by-case basis. Encampments requesting approval to hold an after-hours event are required to first obtain Producer approval in advance, and then are required to notify Security Director Tommy Jones and hire private security for the event. Additionally, any individuals participating in an after-hours event must be current Festival Participants. In no event is a Patron or any individual not registered as a Participant of the Festival (Current 2017 Season) allowed on Festival Premises at any time.
